## Reporting of the programme of PMDDKY, Pulse Mission and other schemes launched by PM on 11.10.2025

In pursuance to the letter received vide D.O.No.8-11/2025-AMD-PM-Part(2) dated 04<sup>th</sup> October, 2025 through Email on dated 06.10.2025, the programme was organized with respect to PMDDKY, Pulse Mission and other schemes launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister in virtual mode on **11<sup>th</sup> October, 2025** at ICAR-CIAH Bikaner and the report of the programme is as under:

An awareness programme under the *Prime Minister-Dhan Dhaanya Krishi Yojana (PM-DDKY)* was successfully organized at ICAR-CIAH Bikaner and its Regional Station, CHES, Vejalpur, Godhra, Gujarat, with the participation of **659 Farmers** and **159 other participants**. The programme aimed to create awareness among farmers about various agricultural schemes and technologies promoted by the Government of India. The event was graced by the **Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modiji**. The **Hon'ble Union Minister of Agriculture, Shri Shivraj Singh Chauhanji**, who addressed the gathering and highlighted the key features of PM-DDKY. He also emphasized the government's commitment to doubling farmers' income through integrated farming approaches. A significant highlight of the event was the **virtual launch by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modiji**, of several key agricultural missions, including **Natural Farming, Pulses Mission, Animal Husbandry, Fish Farming, and New Agriculture Technologies**. These missions aim to boost sustainable farming, improve productivity, and ensure holistic rural development. During the programme, farmers were informed about the benefits of adopting **natural farming practices**, diversification into **animal husbandry and fisheries**, and the use of **modern technologies** in agriculture. Experts from ICAR also demonstrated innovative farming techniques suited to local conditions. The event concluded with an interactive session, where farmers expressed their enthusiasm and readiness to adopt the new initiatives for improving their livelihoods.
